	situations. She defined the meaning of Role play	
	where the students are assigned different roles to	
	act out a particular scenario.	
	The situation and role play for the session was	
	Situational Dialogues and Role Play: IT Recruiter for	
	US clients. The students practiced using language	
	in context and developed their communication	
	skills by using the language and vocabulary they	
	had learned in class to create a realistic	
	conversation.	
	After the role play exercises, she discussed the	
	feedback in improving language skills. Students	
	were encouraged with constructive feedback. It	
	was a successful session as students were able to	
	practice their language skills in a fun and	
	engaging way, and the role play exercises allowed	
	them to apply what they had learnt in real-life	
	situations.
