- E. Engineering students CS/ IT/EEE/ECE/AI-ML and other relevant circuit branch
- F. Tier 3 / Tier 4 cities/ rural areas

Under TechSaksham program, the Student Development program is scheduled to begin from 01st week of September 2023. To register for this SDP, please fill in the nomination form Nomination Form.url. Based on the form responses and interest received we will reach out to all and share the orientation schedule, registration form and training schedule.

Note-

- The last date to mark your nomination is 22nd August 2023.
- The training will be conducted in a blended mode, including both in-person and virtual instructor-led sessions.
- The minimum batch size for a college to participate in the program is 40 and maximum to 100 students. New batches will be formed where more than 100 students are enrolled.

- The training and certification are provided free of cost.
- Preference will be given to students from economically weaker sections (EWS) or marginalized communities for selection in the training program.
- Participation is on a first-come, first-served basis.
