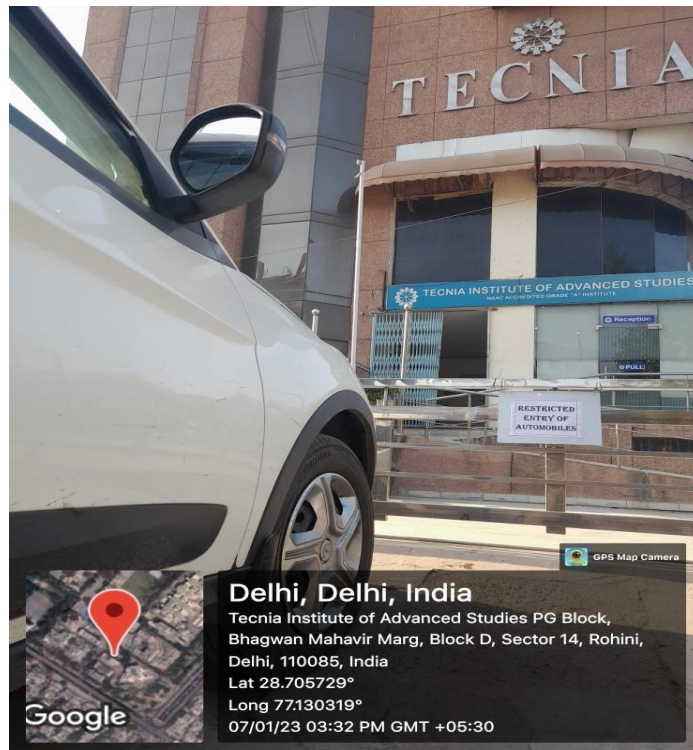

1. RESTRICTED ENTRY OF AUTOMOBILES:

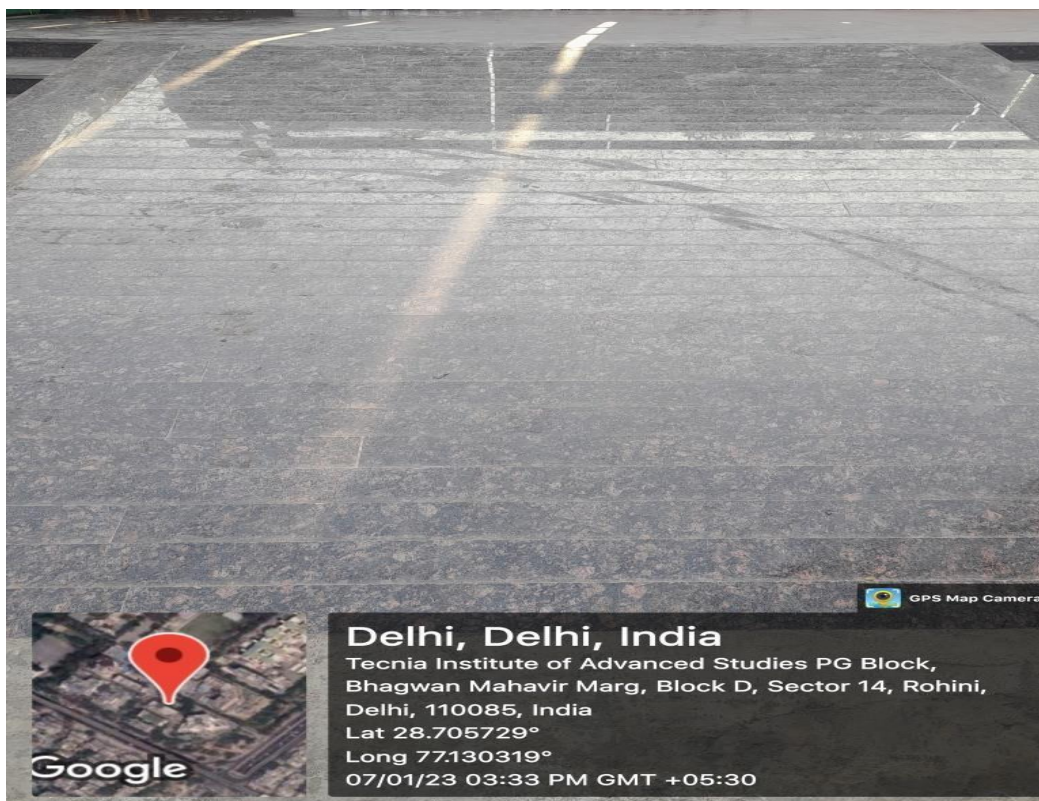

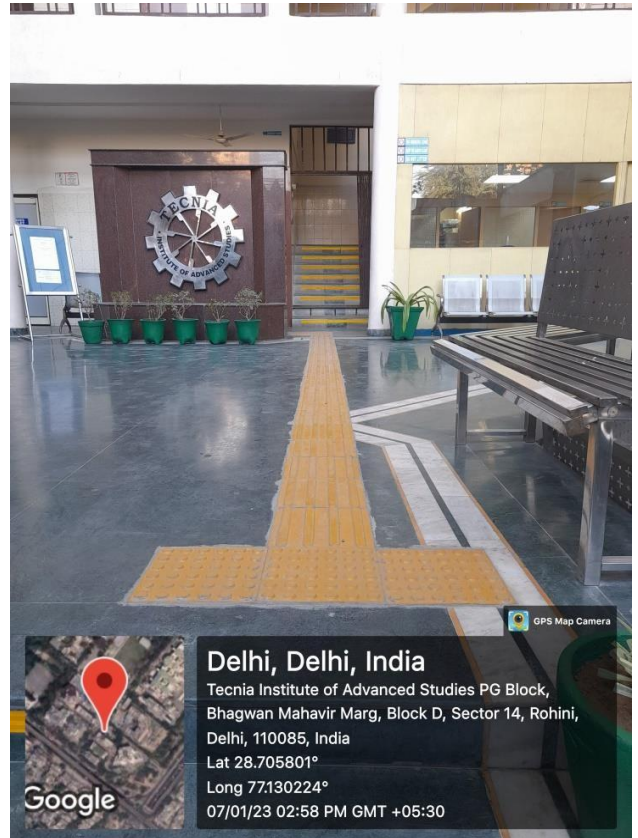


2. PEDESTRIAN FRIENDLY PATHWAYS:

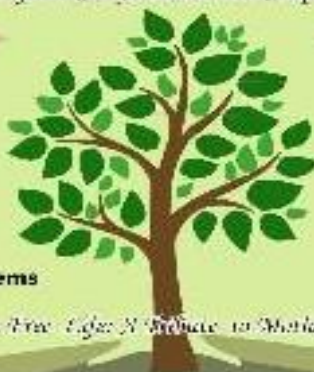

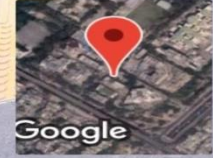
