The methodology must be clearly explained with adequate detail and with sufficient references wherever required.

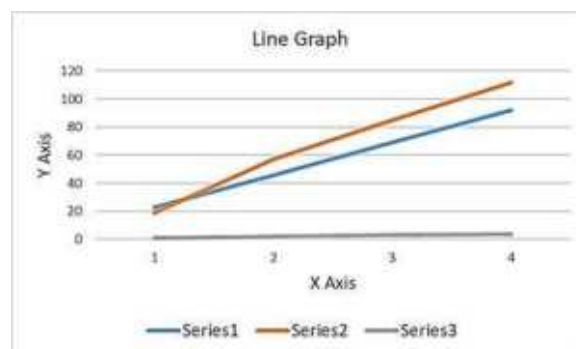
## 4. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (headlines: TNR Bold, 12pt)
