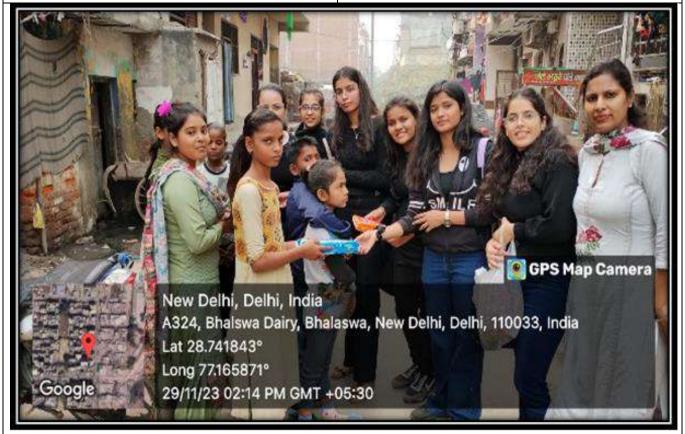

TIAS students interact with community girls for a hygiene initiative

On November 29th, an awareness program on women's hygiene was held at Bhalswa Dairy. It was an initiative by TIAS students to combat social stigma. The project successfully raised awareness about the significance of proper hygiene practices in preventing infections, particularly during menstruation. Students interacted and encouraged the use of sanitary napkins rather than cloth, which is a positive step because it can help minimize bacterial infections and improve overall comfort and hygiene during menstruation. While promoting sanitary napkins is important, participants were also given practical tips on how to use and dispose these items. They also informed them that sanitary napkins could be obtained at a reduced cost at the government-owned Jan Aushadhi Kendra.

Overall, the women's hygiene awareness program at Bhalswa Dairy appears to be a worthwhile initiative with the potential to improve the health and well-being of women in the community. Building on existing efforts and identifying possible areas for improvement, such programs can make a substantial contribution to breaking down taboos and ensuring everyone has access to safe and dignified menstruation hygiene.
