

Report: Description in (min 250 to max 800 words)*

In commemoration of the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, an awareness campaign on sanitation was organised by the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell of the Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies, affiliated with GGSIPU, on September 29, 2023. The campaign took place under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0 initiative by the government of India at Bakhtawar Pur village in New West Delhi. Under the supervision of coordinator Dr. Rajnesh Kumar Pandey, a group of volunteers from the institute visited the village to raise awareness among the villagers about sanitation and maintaining personal hygiene. Volunteers marched on the streets of Bakhtawar Pur with posters, conveyed messages, and raised slogans related to sanitation. Along with sloganeering, student volunteers actively communicated with the local vendors, shopkeepers, and residents of the village and discussed ways of maintaining hygiene on a personal level. A primary school in the area was also visited by the volunteers to educate little kids about the importance of personal hygiene. It was surprising and quite endearing to witness the cleanliness maintained

Some local vendors were seen selling uncovered fast food prepared in unhygienic conditions. Students were guided in the right ways to keep cooked food covered and hygienic. This initiative by the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell of the institute stands as a testament to the institute's dedication to the betterment of society.
