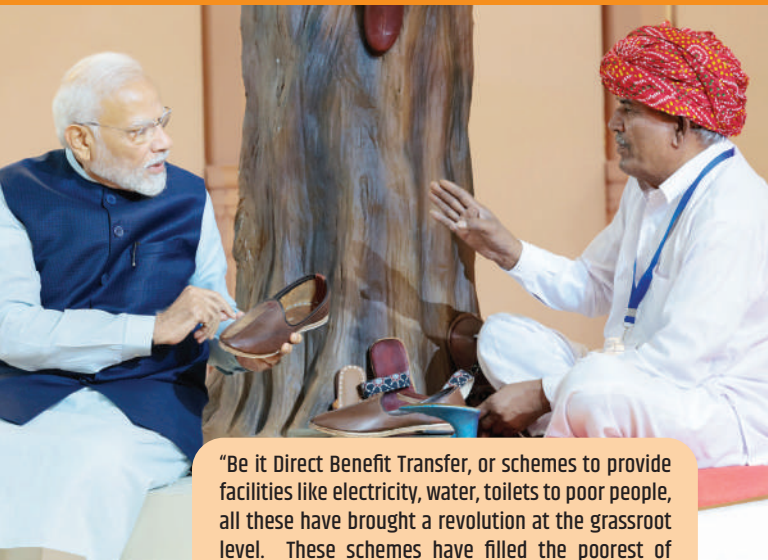

- Over 23 crore Soil Health Cards (SHCs) distributed to farmers

International Year of Millets

Recognising the importance of coarse grains in providing nutritious food to the people and creating indigenous and global demand, the Government of India, on the initiative of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, played a leading role in declaring 2023 the International Year of Millets in the United Nations General Assembly. India's proposal was supported by 72 countries and in March 2021 itself, the United Nations declared the year 2023 as the International Year of Millets.

Kisan Credit Cards (KCC)

- All PM-KISAN beneficiaries to be covered through KCC under a special drive
- 7.34 crore KCC applications have been sanctioned with a sanctioned credit limit of Rs. 8.85 lakh crore (as on March 31, 2023)

- Rs. 1 lakh crore financing facility for creation and modernisation of post-harvest management infrastructure and community farming assets
- In less than 3 years of scheme implementation, more than 38,326 projects have been sanctioned which has mobilised Rs.30,030 crores in agriculture infrastructure sector with a total loan worth Rs.50,988 crore

- Completed agri infra projects have generated employment opportunities for more than 5.8 lakh manpower, while saving 3.7 LMT food grains and 46.3 LMT Horticulture produce annually and ensuring better price realization by farmers to the extent of 20-25%

PM-PRANAM

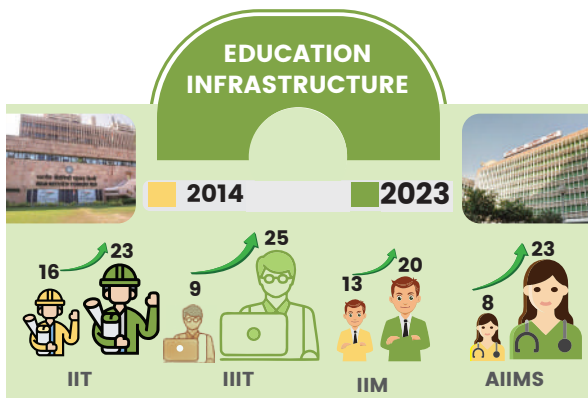

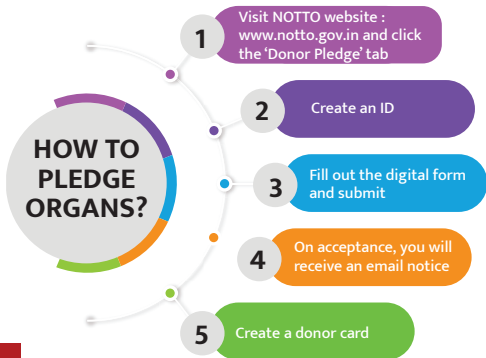
PM Jan Aushadhi Yojana (PMJAY)

- Quality medicines are available at affordable rates at more than 9996 Pradhan Mantri Bharatiya Jan Aushadhi Centers across the country (as on Sept 30, 2023)
- 1965 types of medicines and 293 other medical equipment available in Jan Aushadhi Centers
- Medicines available at these PM Jan Aushadhi centers are available at 50% to 90% cheaper rates than branded medicines



Organ Donation

- To facilitate organ donation, government has enabled people to register their pledge of organ donation on NOTTO's website
- In 2014, the government introduced the concept of Green Corridor, a demarcated special road route cleared for ambulances that enables organs received for transplantation to reach the destination hospital.
- In 2013, there were less than 5,000 organ donations taking place in the country; in 2022 it increased to more than 15,000.



COVID-19 Vaccination Drive

- More than 220 Crore Vaccine Doses administered
- Co-WIN generated:-
 - i. First dose certificates- more than 102.74 crore
 - ii. Second dose certificates- more than 95.21 crore
 - iii. Precautionary dose certificates - more than 22.87 crore

"India has selected the theme of 'One Earth, One Family, One Future' for its G20 Presidency. It signals the need for unity of purpose and unity of action."

India's G-20 Presidency

- The Prime Minister's approach of Jan Bhagidari involved broad sections of our society in the G20 programmes and activities
- The 200 plus meetings in 60 cities represented an unprecedented footprint for G20 events. As a result, the Indian G20 Presidency was truly people-centric and emerged as a national endeavour
- The New Delhi Summit provided an occasion for demonstration of India's contemporary technology advancement as well as of our heritage, culture and traditions. This was widely appreciated by leaders and delegates of G20 member-states
- The conclusion of the **India-Middle East-Europe Economic Corridor Agreement** and the Global Biofuels Alliance during the Summit were also developments of considerable significance

Operation Ajay

- India launched 'Operation Ajay' to evacuate Indian national from Israel
- A 24-hour Control Room set up in the Ministry of External Affairs to monitor the situation and provide information and assistance

Operation Ganga

- Successfully brought back 23,000 Indian Nationals from Ukraine
- 147 citizens from 18 countries also evacuated
- 90 tonnes of relief material provided



Operation Dost

- Indian Army Field Hospital provided emergency medical care over 3,600 people in Hatya Province of quake-hit Turkey.

Developmental Issues

- Accelerated implementation of PMDP, 53 PMDP projects with an outlay of Rs. 58,477 crore under implementation in Jammu and Kashmir. 9 projects with an outlay of Rs. 21,441 crore under implementation in Ladakh. 32 projects in J&K and 3 projects in Ladakh have been completed/substantially completed

- Government has rolled out the New Central Sector Scheme with an outlay of Rs. 28,400 crore, for industrial development of Jammu and Kashmir which envisages incentives like Capital Investment Incentive, Capital Interest subvention, GST Linked Incentive, Working Capital Interest Incentive

Agnipath Scheme

- Agnipath is a game changer scheme for the Armed Forces which is going to act as force multiplier in making Indian military as one of the best in the world with youthful, high-tech and ultra-modern outlook
- The Government has launched Agnipath scheme on June 15, 2022 to recruit both male and female aspirants into 'below the officer's rank' cadre of the three services for a period of four years as Agniveers
- Candidates between the age group of 17.5 to 21 years are eligible to apply for the scheme

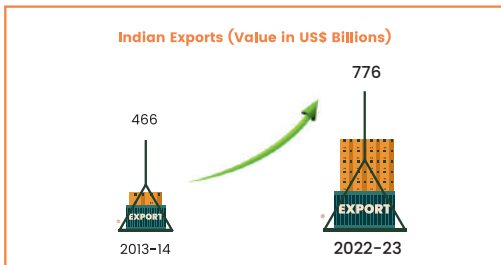

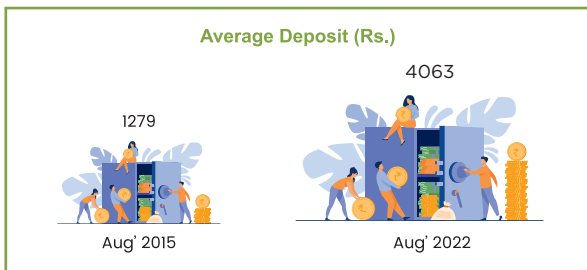

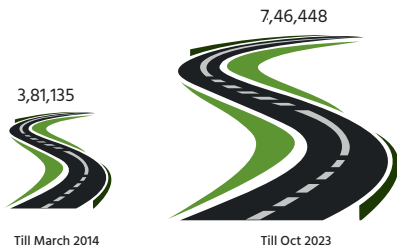
National Highway Network (in KM)

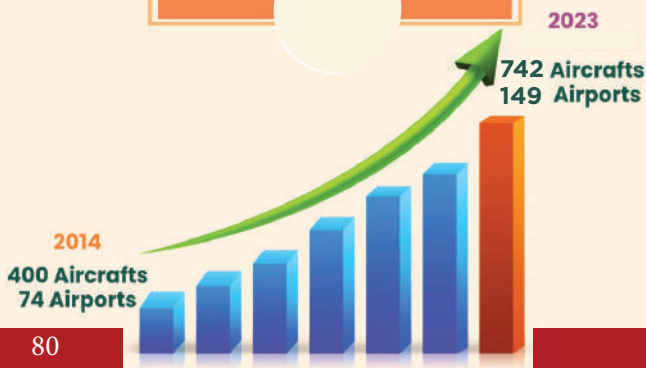

- Before 2014, there were only 9 airports in the North-East, 7 new airports built in the north-east in the last 9 years

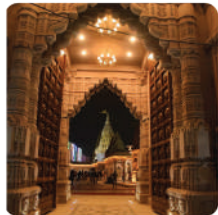

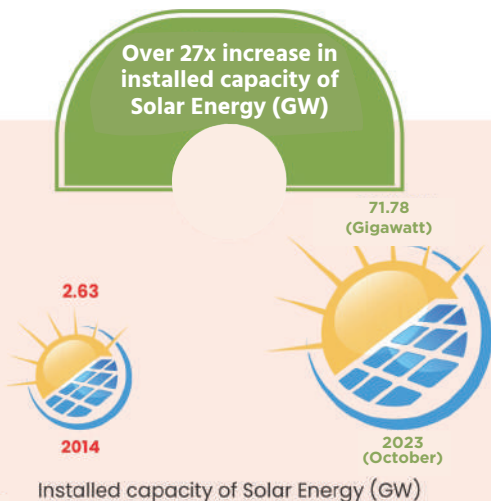
Global Biofuel Alliance (GBA)

- The Global Biofuel Alliance (GBA) is an initiative by India as the G20 Chair
- The Alliance intends to expedite the global uptake of biofuels through facilitating technology advancements, intensifying utilization of sustainable biofuels, shaping robust standard setting and certification through the participation of a wide spectrum of stakeholders.
- The alliance will also act as a central repository of knowledge and an expert hub.

Massive Increase in Renewable Energy

- Renewable energy (RE) installed capacity increased 2.37 times in last 9 years
- India now at 4th position globally for installed RE capacity

- Solar capacity increased from 2.63 GW to over 71.78 GW between 2014 and September 2023; solar park scheme doubled from 20 GW to 40 GW; record low solar tariff at Rs 1.99/unit achieved
- National Hydrogen Mission announced on August 15, 2021 to aid production of 5 million tonnes of green hydrogen fuel by 2030. Mission approved by Union Cabinet on Jan 04, 2023



GOBARdhan

- ‘Galvanizing Organic Bio-Agro Resources Dhan’ (GOBARdhan) scheme was formally launched on 30 April, 2018 as a part of SBM-G
- GOBARdhan is a Waste to Wealth initiative in tune with the circular economy and Mission LiFE initiatives of GoI
- Focus is on setting up of community projects for scientific management of bio-waste, ensuring cleanliness in villages and generating wealth and energy by converting cattle dung and solid agricultural waste into compost and biogas
- In Phase-II of SBM (G) there is a provision of up to Rs. 50 lakh per district for setting up of community GOBARdhan Projects. At least 1 GOBARdhan plant is mandatory per district as per the operational guidelines of SBM(G)
