While they offer potential benefits in security and evidence collection, they also raise concerns about privacy and trust. It's crucial to find a balance by implementing targeted measures, establishing clear policies and communication, and exploring alternative solutions that minimize privacy concerns while addressing security needs. Ultimately, the decision to use CCTV cameras should be made in a transparent and informed manner, considering the specific context and the well-being of both the organization and its employees.</p>
