The students introduced the topic, then further discussed on the positives and negatives in relation to the topic.</p> <p>As the topic suggests about “Crypto currency: Boom or Bane” helps in achieving a better knowledge of crypto currency, also it helps to understand its uses in daily life, A crypto currency is a digital currency, which is an alternative form of payment created using encryption algorithms.</p> <p>Below are some points which we students discussed on the positives and negatives on the topic; Positive are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- Removes single points of failure 2- Easier to transfer funds between parties 3- Removes third parties 4- Can be used to generate returns 5- Remittances are streamlined <p>Negatives are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- Transactions are pseudonymous 2- Pseudonymity allows for criminal uses 3- Have become highly centralized 4- Expensive to participate in a network and earn 5- Off-chain security issues <p>Overall, Crypto currencies are digital assets that are secured by cryptography. As a relatively new technology, they are highly speculative, and it is important to understand the risks involved before investing.</p>
