



The resource person Dr. Poonam Dua discussed about situational dialogues and their importance in language learning and stated that situational dialogues are conversations that take place in specific situations, such as ordering food at a restaurant or buying tickets at a movie theatre. She further added that practicing such simulations is important as it provide an opportunity for applying practical language skills that they can use in real-life situations.
