This can encourage investment in education and training programs.
Some Disadvantages attached with Impact of Technology on Job Market are: - It creates unemployment and income inequality as automation is a major concern, as machines can increasingly perform tasks previously done by humans; - It helps in skill gap as with the rapid pace of technological change can leave some workers behind if they lack the necessary skills to adapt; - Also it leads to lack of human interaction as over-reliance on technology can decrease the need for face-to-face interaction in jobs.
So at last, Technology's impact on the job market is a double-edged sword, bringing both positive and negative changes, so the ideal approach lies is that technology to use it in an effective manner thereby leading to increasing productivity creating new opportunities.
