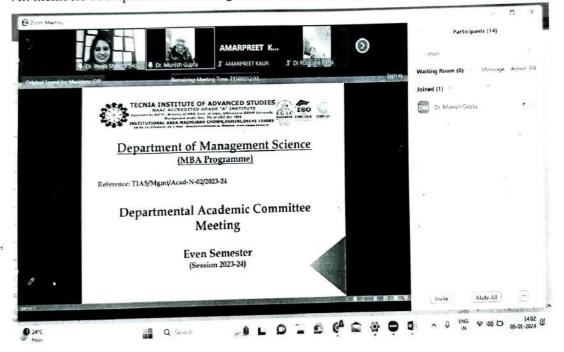

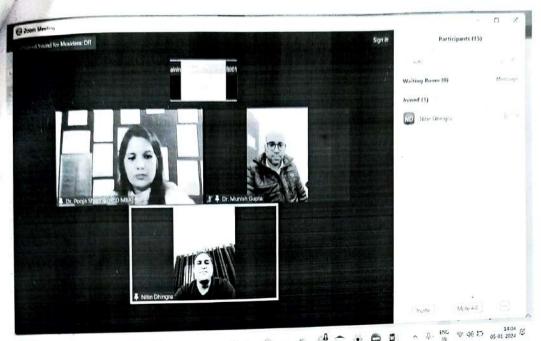

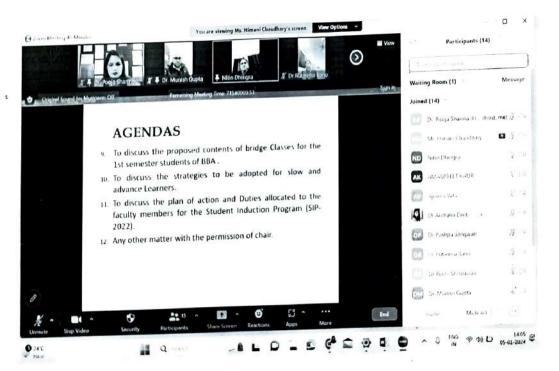
Minutes of the Meeting
