- Paper should contain abstract not more than 500 words along with key words.

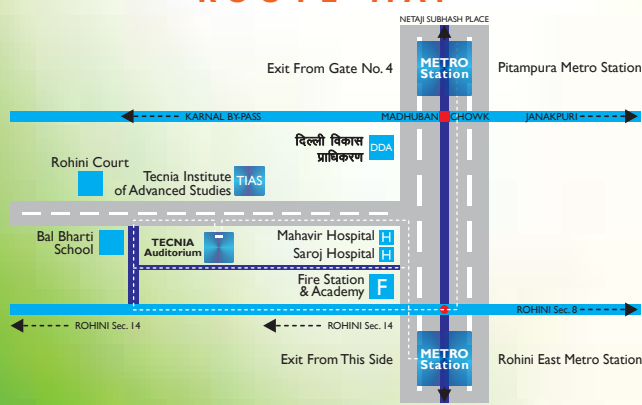
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ROUTE MAP
