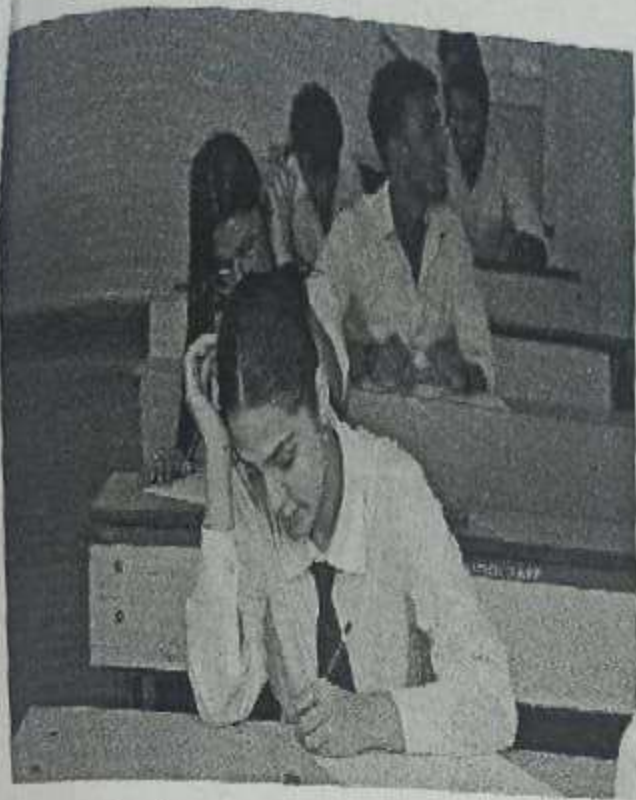

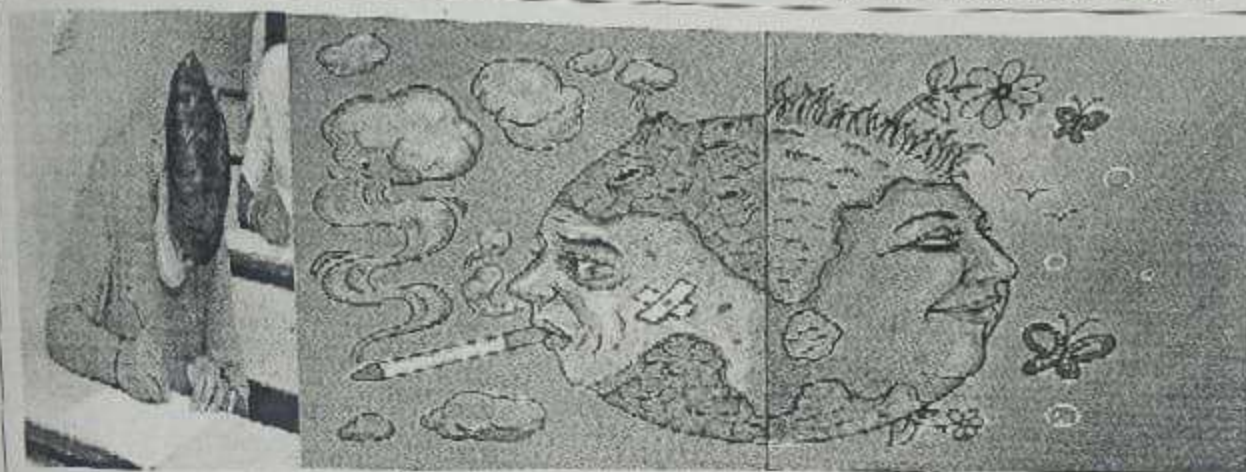

Posters Designed by Students at Tecnia


