Overall Feedback Analysis

Students & alumni members widely commend the fairness and transparency of the examination and evaluation system. Few students have internal assessment procedures could be enhanced for better clarity and consistency.

Alumni students and faculty members have highlighted the significant role that robust sports facilities play in contributing to students' physical well-being, fostering teamwork, and providing stress relief. They emphasize that these elements are crucial for a well-rounded educational experience, suggesting that enhancing sports facilities would further support students' overall development and well-being.

Parents & Alumni members have voiced concerns regarding the accessibility and visibility of pertinent information on the Institute's website. They believe that details about academic programs, admission procedures, and institutional policies should be displayed on website. There is a call for improvements to the website's layout and content to ensure that it provides comprehensive, easily navigable, and up-to-date information that meets the needs of prospective and current students and their families.

It has been observed by faculty members and employers that their level of participation is currently lower than anticipated. This limited involvement may impact the depth and relevance of the curriculum, suggesting a need for increased engagement from faculty to ensure that the curriculum remains robust and responsive to both educational standards and industry needs.

Employers have expressed concerns regarding the commitment of selected students to work beyond standard hours during instances of stretch hours or extended work periods. They have noted that some students may be reluctant or unwilling to put in additional time when projects or tasks require it, which can impact overall productivity and project outcomes. This issue highlights the need for students to develop a stronger work ethic and time management skills that include the ability to adapt to extended work schedules when necessary. Addressing this concern may involve incorporating training and practical experiences that better prepare students for the demands of the workplace, ensuring they are more adaptable and reliable in professional settings.

The feedback from various stakeholders across the Management, MCA, and BA-JMC departments highlights a commendable alignment with contemporary industry needs and a proactive stance towards enhancing their educational experiences. Respondents have advocated for the integration of specialized courses into the curriculum, reflecting their desire to acquire practical skills that are directly relevant to their future careers. Specifically, there is a call for the introduction of a Certificate Course in NISM Mutual Fund (Foundation Module) for MBA students, aimed at deepening their financial expertise. For BBA students there should be Courses in Data Analytics and Advanced Excel, recognizing the importance of these skills in today's data-driven business environment. BCA students require training in Office Automation and Python, reflecting their aim to stay current with essential technological advancements. Additionally, for BA(JMC) students the focus should be on Professional Learning of Public Relations & Advertising, as well as Hindi Typing and Hindi News Writing, to better prepare them for the dynamic media and communication landscape. Overall, these suggestions underscore a clear demand for educational offerings that are not only relevant but also strategically aligned with the evolving requirements of the job market.
