

The outreach activity titled "Bringing Stories to Life: The Power of Puppetry in Education" was organized on February 10, 2020, in Shahbad Dairy by tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies. The event aimed to leverage the engaging medium of puppetry to address the critical issue of gender-based violence (GBV) and promote gender equality. By using storytelling as a tool for education, the initiative sought to raise awareness, spark discussions, and inspire positive change within the community.

The event commenced with a captivating puppet show that presented a series of stories illustrating the impacts of gender-based violence on individuals and communities. The performance was designed to be both entertaining and educational, allowing the audience to engage with the characters and themes in a relatable manner. By showcasing diverse narratives that highlighted the consequences of GBV, the puppetry effectively communicated the urgencies of

These workshops fostered an environment of collaboration and encouraged participants to consider innovative ways to raise awareness and challenge societal norms.</p> <p>A discussion featuring experts in gender studies and community activism provided participants with valuable insights into the systemic issues surrounding gender-based violence. The volunteers emphasized the importance of education and awareness in preventing GBV and discussed strategies for fostering a culture of respect and equality. Participants actively engaged in the discussion, sharing their own experiences and ideas for further community initiatives.</p> <p>The outreach activity successfully highlighted the power of puppetry as a medium for education and advocacy against gender-based violence. Participants left with a deeper understanding of the issue and the tools to address it within their communities. By combining creative expression with important social themes, the event not only raised awareness about GBV but also empowered individuals to become advocates for change. The success of this outreach initiative paves the way for future activities focused on using art and storytelling as vehicles for education and social justice.</p>
