REPORT

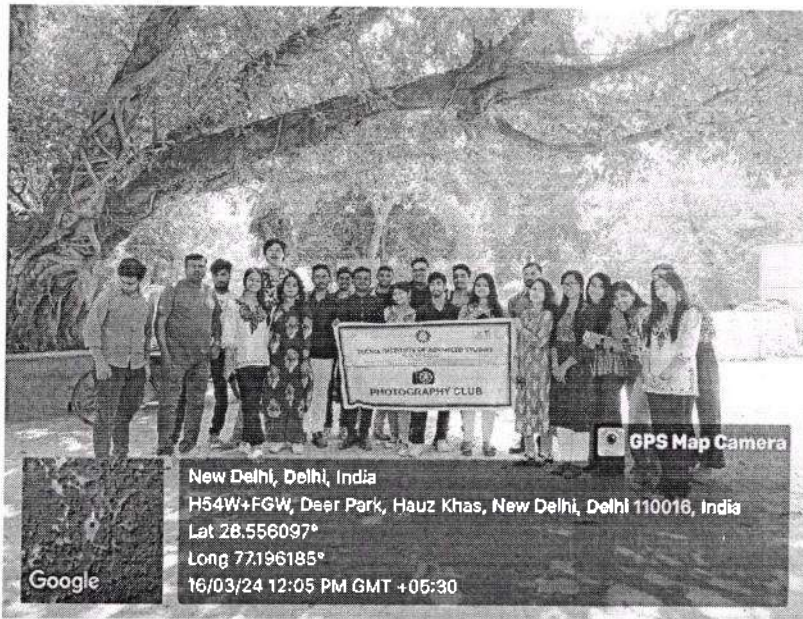
