

The street play competition at Anugoonj 2024, hosted by Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU), was an extraordinary platform where numerous colleges from across Delhi participated, showcasing their talent in dramatics. Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies (TIAS) sent a well-prepared team of students, coordinated by faculty member Ms. Sonia Batra. Under her mentorship, the team presented a highly impactful street play that focused on pressing societal issues surrounding gender equality and social justice.

Held over three days, from 8th to 10th February 2024, the competition saw intense performances that addressed various themes from social stigmas, inequalities, and discrimination to human rights. TIAS's play stood out for its passionate portrayal of widowhood and its effects on individuals and society. The play explored the deep-seated challenges faced by widows in everyday life and called for equality through powerful dialogues, engaging street play tactics, and strong performances. Team Mridang, led by Shivang Misra, captivated the audience with their bold representation, body language, and synchronized performance.

The street play aimed not only to entertain but also to engage the audience in meaningful reflection on how society can be more inclusive and just. The performance, rich in symbolism and raw energy, ended on a hopeful note, offering solutions and
