Report: Description in (min 250 to max 800 words)*	Theatre Fest Badlaav' 24, organized by Rukmini Devi Institute of Advanced Studies (RDIAS), took place on 16th March 2024, providing a platform for various colleges and institutions to participate in socially driven theatre. The event, which attracted

	 a large number of participants, aimed to bring attention to societal issues through the power of street theatre. Mridang Theatre Society, led by Shivang Misra, secured the 2nd position with their thought-provoking street play. The play BE-RANG performed by TIAS students addressed the theme of the challenges faced by widows in society. Using minimalistic props and dynamic movements, the team delivered a powerful message about breaking stereotypes and advocating for equal opportunities for all genders. The performance was high in energy and creativity, capturing the attention of both the audience and the judges.
	The script, penned by the students themselves, portrayed various societal pressures that widows experience, including workplace discrimination and societal expectations. Through a series of impactful dialogues and emotionally charged scenes, the team showcased the importance of standing up for one's rights and dismantling outdated societal norms.
	The team's ability to engage with the audience and create a narrative that was both relatable and moving earned them praise from the judging panel. Their performance not only entertained but also raised important questions about gender roles in contemporary society.
	The Theatre Fest Badlaav' 24 was a successful event that encouraged students to use their voices for advocacy through the medium of street theatre. Pratigya, The Cultural Society at RDIAS deserves credit for creating a space where students could explore critical issues and work collaboratively to create impactful performances. The teams exemplified how street theatre can be an effective tool for social awareness and change.
