





On 26th February 2022, the Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies organized an outreach program titled "*Strengthening Democracy: Leveraging Citizen Services for National Growth*" at Bhalswa Dairy. The event, which began at 11:30 AM, focused on promoting awareness of the *e-EPIC* (digital version of the Electoral Photo Identity Card) and its benefits.


The student volunteers educated community members about the significance of *e-EPIC*, a secure, portable, and digitally accessible alternative to traditional voter ID cards. The session highlighted its role in simplifying electoral processes and fostering inclusivity by enabling citizens to access their voter ID on any digital device.


Key activities during the program included:


1. **Introduction to e-EPIC:** Volunteers explained the concept, benefits, and eligibility criteria for obtaining the digital voter ID.
2. **Step-by-Step Guidance:** Participants were shown how to download *e-EPIC* from the National Voter Service Portal (NVSP) or the Voter Helpline App, covering:
 - Registration/login process.
 - Verifying voter credentials.
 - Downloading the e-EPIC file.
3. **Hands-On Assistance:** Residents received individual support in navigating the platform, ensuring they successfully downloaded their digital voter ID.
4. **Awareness Campaign:** Posters and pamphlets were distributed, emphasizing the ease, security, and portability of the digital card.




