The play used a mix of humor, drama, and impactful dialogues to convey its message, leaving a lasting impression on the audience.

The actors from Mridang Theatre Society, TIAS demonstrated exceptional coordination, delivering strong performances that were both entertaining and educational. The minimal use of props and reliance on dynamic acting highlighted their creativity and ability to capture the audience's
