- Live streaming or providing real-time updates of the event on platforms like Instagram, Facebook, or Twitter.
- Creating event hashtags and encouraging participants and attendees to use them in their posts.
- Posting recaps, highlights, and photo/video content post-event to showcase the success of the cultural activities and build community engagement.
