

The Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies organized an impactful outreach program on DEMOCRACY IN ACTION, Citizen Duties and Rights: New Voter Registration - 18 Years Or Above, (Filling up the Application Form: 6)on 28th October, 2023 from 12.00 p.m. onwards at Khampur village. The event aimed to educate citizens about their constitutional responsibilities and encourage their participation in the democratic process. A key highlight of the program was an interactive session on Form 6, a critical document for the inclusion of citizens' names in the electoral roll. Volunteers explained its purpose and usage, focusing on two main categories of applicants: first-time voters and individuals who have relocated to a new constituency. Participants were guided stepby-step through the process of filling Form 6, both online and offline. Volunteers demonstrated how to access the form through the National Voter Service Portal (NVSP) and provided information on how to submit it manually to the local Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) or Booth Level Officer (BLO).

Key points discussed about Form 6 included:

- Eligibility Criteria: Indian citizenship, 18 years of age or older, and residence in the constituency.
- **Required Documents:** Birth certificate or Aadhaar for age proof, utility bills or rental agreements for address proof, and a passport-size photograph.
- Verification Process: Details submitted in the form are verified by the ERO or BLO before inclusion in the electoral roll.

The session also stressed the importance of maintaining accurate electoral records to ensure the integrity of elections. The program included engaging discussions on constitutional duties, such as voting, and their role in strengthening democracy. Villagers actively participated, with many filling out,
